



## COMMISSIONER OF LANDS' CIRCULAR NO. 2 OF 1967

### *Implementation of Rural Development Directive No. 2*

Appendix 'A' referred to in paragraph 3(b) (iv) of Commissioner of Lands Circular No. 5 of 1960 dealing with selection of settlers is hereby cancelled and substituted as follows with immediate effect:

#### NEW SYSTEM OF POINT AWARD

1. A preliminary selection of applicants for places in a land development scheme is made on the basis of the particulars submitted in their applications.
2. At the actual interview to facilitate the easy assessment of the suitability of applicants a point system is devised i.e. points are awarded for certain desirable qualities and qualifications possessed by them. The points awarded will be based on the following:

(i) Age of applicant	Maximum points	10
(ii) Agricultural background	Maximum points	10
(iii) No. of children	Maximum points	5
(iv) Ownership of land	Maximum points	5
(v) Physical fitness	Suitable of Unsuitable	

Details of points award are as below:

Age - should be between 21 and 45 years
